

An enchantigly amusing novel that oulines with unique sensitivity and liveliness the adolescent soul.






MAROULA KLIAFA


A Dush of Cumin and a Lot of Love




The Children of the Magic Charms




Two highly admirable women who lived lives that had in store doubts and fears for them, but also triumphs and glory.
